We promote amateur astronomy at every level. The MVAS provides a forum where members can get together to meet, share ideas on astronomy and related subjects, learn from more experienced members, stargaze with friends, and simply enjoy the fellowship of a group of individuals sharing a common interest.

We promote education among our members by inviting guest lecturers who are often professional astronomers or who teach astronomy at regional colleges and universities. Our observatory at John Bryan State Park sports a roll-off roof observatory, a variety of telescopes and a secure building located in a fenced-in compound providing significant security.

Our most important mission is public education. We promote education by bringing astronomy to the public through regular stargazes at John Bryan State Park, schools, scout camps, and other outreach events at other area locations.

The Society began in 1918 as the Dayton Astronomical Society (DAS), and was the first formally organized group of amateur astronomers in the Dayton area. One of its founding members was Colonel Edward Deeds, then president of the National Cash Register Company.

MVAS members have access to the John Bryan Observatory located inside the John Bryan State Park, near Yellow Springs, Ohio.


The John Bryan Observatory is our club's premier observing site. It is a terrific facility and one of our best membership benefits with access to an impressive array of astronomical equipment.
